

## **Assembly Instructions – Shrines, Cubbies & Displays**



When you receive your kit it will come with all the individual pieces ready to assemble. Use a good quality glue for best results. Smaller shrine kits may come in a backing sheet.

You can paint the parts before assembly but ensure you avoid the finger joints or assembly may be difficult. If you are going to line with paper, use the unassembled parts as a pattern - mark the corners on the paper reverse – cut to make the rectangle.



Assemble the box frame by gluing the sides and end pieces together – make sure the flat edges are all the same way up.

If you have a kit with a shelf, glue the shelf into the slots at this stage before attaching the last piece of frame.



The back piece should slot in quite comfortably.

You may wish to use low tack masking tape or elastic bands to hold the piece together as it dries.



If you haven't already, you may wish to paint or decorate the inside before gluing on the front piece/frame.

Once fully assembled and dried, you can add any additional embellishments that come with the kit or add your own to create a totally unique piece.



If you chose to use the optional feet, glue these together as a stack (as high as you like!) and once dry, attach to the bottom of the piece.
